

## Cue Sheet: GMBC Covered Bridges of Chittenden County Ride (CCW)

0.0	0.0	Start at Dorset (Veterans Memorial) Park. Continue straight across Dorset St onto Swift St at light.	S	
0.7	0.7	Turn left onto Spear St.	S	
5.6	4.9	Turn right onto Irish Hill Rd	WSW	
7.1	1.5	Cross US-7 and continue on Bostwick Rd. Cambridge Covered Bridge on right, down US-7, at Shelburne Museum. Built 1845, moved from Cambridge in 1950. One of six double lane CBs in US and only one with footbridge.	WSW	
10.6	3.5	Turn right onto Lake Rd	WSW	
12.0	1.4	Holmes Creek (Lakeshore) covered bridge. Use caution crossing.	--	
13.8	1.8	Left onto Ferry Rd.	E

14.9	1.1	Continue straight across Greenbush Rd. Break at store. Long ride turns right onto Greenbush.	E	
15.2	0.3	Continue straight across Rt. 7 onto Church Hill Rd. Watch traffic!	E	
15.9	0.7	Bear right at stop onto Hinesburg Rd.	E	
18.1	2.2	Turn left onto Spear St. at light, rejoining long ride. Store here.	N

14.9	1.1	Right onto Greenbush Rd..	S	
16.7	1.8	Continue on Greenbush Rd at Thompson's Pt. Rd.	S	
19.0	2.3	Left onto Stage Rd.	NE	
20.0	1.0	Break at store, then continue across Rte. 7 onto Old Hollow Rd. Watch traffic!	E	
20.3	0.3	Turn left onto Mt. Philo Rd.	N	
20.8	0.5	Bear right onto Spear St.	NE	
22.9	2.1	Quinlan Covered Bridge on right. <i>Optional route crosses bridge, makes immediate left onto Lewis Creek Rd., then left on Roscoe Rd. to Seguin CB. Then left on Prindle Rd. to return to Spear St. Includes some dirt.</i>	NE

### Ride Rules

- Everyone must wear a helmet and straps should be adjusted correctly.
- Follow all traffic laws, including obeying signals.
- If the ride will wait for people at intersections, discuss this at the start.
- Use your own judgment at each stop sign. Don't yell out "Clear" for the next rider.
- Use hand signals for turns and to point out road hazards (If there are new people, review the rules.)
- Wear visible clothing. In fog and rain, you might also want lights.
- If there is a thunderstorm, get away from your bicycle and seek shelter in a building or a stand of trees (not a lone tree).
- Get license plate or description of harassing drivers, and report it to the police, the ride leader and the Vt Bike/Ped Coalition.
- Single up when cars are passing, out of courtesy.
- Wave your thanks to drivers who are polite and wait for you or even drivers who are a little rude.
- Finally, a quick safety check for your bike: ABC Quick Check
  - A=Air in tires
  - B= Brakes working
  - C=Chain lubed and crank in good shape
  - Quick=Quick releases tight
  - Check=Make sure everything else seems OK
